

RainHarvest Systems Partners with 5 Seasons Restaurant and Brewery to Produce Rainwater Beer

RainHarvest Systems has partnered with Atlanta's premier micro brewery - 5 Seasons Restaurant and Brewery, to produce beer made entirely from rainwater that is captured and filtered on-site.

Good beer starts with good water... And mother nature's rainwater arrives naturally without the chlorine, taste and carbon footprint that comes with tap water used by traditional breweries.

According to Crawford Moran, biermeister for 5 Seasons: "The processed rainwater not only fulfills our commitment to environmentally responsible production, but it also tastes better than municipal water, which ultimately makes a smoother, better tasting beer."

5 Seasons is setting new standards for environmentally sustainable production. Even the burners that boil what brewmasters call "wort" (the blend of ingredients used to make beer) are fueled by used vegetable oil from the kitchen.

RainHarvest Systems is the industry expert in rainwater filtration and the system installed at the brewery is comprised of 6 stages of filtration followed by dual-beam ultraviolet sterilization which results in water quality which far exceeds municipal tap water. Systems like the one installed at 5 Seasons are becoming more commonplace with water shortages and restrictions convincing end users to look for sustainable alternatives.

As part of the partnership, 5 Seasons Brewery is producing beer to be used by RainHarvest Systems for publicity events intended to promote public awareness of rainwater collection. The first such event will be showcased on September 14th, 2009 at 7PM at The Decatur Square in Decatur, Georgia, during the National Conference for the American Rainwater Catchment Systems Association (ARCOSA). Connoisseurs who want an advance trial of the beer can find it at the 5 Seasons Westside location in Atlanta at 5:55 PM (as is standard for one of their inaugural batches of brew) on the same day.

All future brews from 5 Seasons Restaurant and Brewery will be produced from rainwater, making them the premiere brewery in the United States to be based completely on captured rainwater.
