

GETTING STARTED

- To keep your energy efficient rainwater garden pump operating optimally, some maintenance may be required.
- Required tools: Phillips screwdriver and a 5 mm hex wrench. A rubber mallet may be helpful.

1 Remove the six Phillips screws at the base of the pump.



2 It may be necessary to tap the base cover off with a rubber mallet once the screws are loose. Notice where the spacer is at the bottom of the impeller stack.



3 Using a 5 mm hex wrench, remove the bolt holding the impeller stack.



4 The impeller stack can be removed and pulled apart for cleaning. Notice the orientation of the impellers and housings.



5 Reassemble in reverse order.
